Original Moving Wall to be displayed at Ivy Lawn Memorial Park in August 2010.

Vietnam Veterans of Ventura County, Inc. (VVVC) and Ivy Lawn Memorial Park are co-sponsoring a display of the "original Moving Wall" from August 26 through August 30, 2010 at Ivy Lawn Memorial Park in Ventura. This display will be open 24 hours during the duration.

The Moving Wall is a half-scale mobile replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall located in Washington, DC, which was founded by Vietnam Veterans John Devitt, Gerry Haver and Norris Shears, and first placed it on public display in 1984.

The VVVC is seeking donations from other Veteran Organizations as well as the general public, to help offset expenses that will be incurred during the display of the Wall. They are also seeking volunteers to assist with finding of names on the Wall and to provide rubbings for those that have friend or loved ones listed.
